Terms and Conditions for the supply of a Mobile Crèche

1. These terms and conditions shall represent a legally binding contract between (the event organiser) the "Client" and (Kiddykare Ltd) "Kiddykare". All variations shall be agreed by the parties in writing. The verbal or written instruction by the Client to Kiddykare to provide a suitable crèche service shall constitute acceptance by the Client of these terms and conditions. The term "Kiddykarer" means a person/persons whose service are supplied by Kiddykare Ltd to the Client for operating a mobile crèche. When supplying a Kiddykarer, Kiddykare are acting as an employment business and supplying the Kiddykarer under a contract for services.
2. The Client agrees to pay Kiddykare 50% of the total invoice on making the booking for the event and the remaining 50% of the invoice 24 hours before the event is due to commence. Kiddykare reserve the right to charge the Client a 20% surcharge on all accounts not settled within this period.
3. If a booking is cancelled, Kiddykare reserve the right to charge a cancellation fee based on a percentage of the total invoice and the agreed date of the event, as follows:
 - Within 3 months a fee of 10%
 - Within 2 months a fee of 50%
 - Within 1 month a fee of 90%
4. There is a minimum booking time of 3 hours for mobile crèches.
5. The final number and ages of children attending must be confirmed 48 hours before the event, Kiddykare work within the ratios set by Government and therefore no increase in these numbers can be accepted after this time. If more children turn up on the day than agreed they will be turned away.
6. Kiddykare are unable to take sick children on the day of the event, if a child becomes ill whilst attending the event, the parent will be contacted and the child removed from the crèche.
7. Kiddykare require access to the facility at least 14 days prior to the event in order to carry out a risk assessment, should the allocated accommodation change in anyway and be considered unsuitable by Kiddykare then Kiddykare reserve the right to cancel the event. The accommodation provided for the event must be secure and separate, sharing space with other facility users is not acceptable.
8. The facility must be available at least 2 hours before and an hour after the event to allow for setting up and taking down any equipment.

9. Should the client pass on any details of a Kiddykarer or recommend a Kiddykarer which results in a permanent, temporary or part time placement of that Kiddykarer, then the Client will be liable for the full Kiddykare agency fee.
10. Kiddykare endeavours to provide the Client with the most suitable Kiddykarers, having performed all the checks required by law. Kiddykare confirms it has all the relevant Insurance in place as required by law for running a mobile crèche.
11. Kiddykare does not accept liability for any kind of inconvenience, loss or damage however arising and whether caused directly or indirectly by an act or omission of a Kiddykarer. Kiddykare does not exclude or restrict liability for death or personal injury resulting from it's negligence.
12. All communication whether written or oral between the parties shall be confidential
